

The Big Picture

- 4,700 acres (7.5 square miles) of planned redevelopment
- 5th best-selling, master-planned community in the United States for the decade 2010-2019; 15th best-selling in 2019; 10th best-selling in 2018; 10th best-selling in 2017; 13th best-selling in 2016; 4th best-selling in 2015; 6th best-selling in 2014; 11th best-selling in 2013; and 10th best-selling in 2012*
- The first homeowner moved into the community in 2002
- 33,000 residents (and counting), roughly the population of the City of Wheat Ridge
- 14,000 homes planned at completion: 9,000 single family (including townhomes), 5,000 apartments
- 3.3 million square feet of existing flex/industrial space
- 2.6 million square feet of retail space has already been developed
